Tee Ball & Instructional Baseball: Registration is currently open for Tee Ball and Instructional Baseball. Games and practice sessions are held on Saturday mornings only. Please see the registration form on the back of this flyer for more information.

Dramatic Arts for Children: Children will participate in exercises and games that foster the skills needed to perform in a play. They will develop self-confidence by using their creativity in small skits and activities meant to increase awareness of their own special talents. Children ages 5-7 will meet on Monday afternoons from 4-5:30PM beginning March 30th in the Activities Center. Sessions for 8-13 year old children will be held on Fridays beginning April 3rd from 6-7:30PM in the Activities Center. The registration fee for the *six-week session* is \$70 for Hopkinton residents and \$75 for non-residents; 10% discount for siblings attending. The instructor is Diane Bentley.

Children ages 8-12 are welcome to attend this hands-on craft class that will incorporate many craft mediums such as clays, paints, and journal materials. This 6-week class will include teaching children basic yoga postures, breathing, and body awareness in a fun and easy environment. Instructor Amy Van Oot has been practicing Active Vinyasa Yoga for four years and enjoys mentoring young children towards a healthy and happy lifestyle. All kids in grades K-4 are welcome. The fee is \$24 for residents of Hopkinton and \$28 for non-residents. Class size is limited; families with more than one child attending will receive a discount, call for more details.
