Summer Camp at Crandall Field: June 29-August 28:

This program is open to all children going into grades K-6 in September. Program hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30AM-3:30PM. Morning and afternoon extended hours will also be available. The program includes outdoor activities, arts and crafts, swimming, field trips, and special guests and performers. Participants are required to bring a lunch, snacks, a water bottle, sunscreen, and admission costs for field trips. Tuition for Hopkinton residents is \$30/day or for children enrolled Monday through Friday \$125/wk. Tuition for non-residents is \$35/day and \$150/wk respectively. Registration is mandatory. Families with more than one child attending camp will receive a discount; call the recreation department for more information. A non-refundable deposit of half your child's tuition for the first week he/she is planning on attending camp is required at registration. Full time campers may register online or register at the Crandall House. Forms are also available online at HopkintonRi.org.

Players will receive individual and group instruction from coaches that love the game of basketball. The camp will include shooting instruction with related drills, contests, prizes, special guests, camp certification, and lots of fun! All players will also receive a T-shirt and basketball. A \$75 deposit is required at the time of registration; **an updated physical form or a doctor's written consent from your child's pediatrician is required by the first day of camp.** Players must bring a water bottle and a bag lunch.

Dramatic Arts Camp: July 20-24 and August 17-21 9:00AM-3:00PM at Crandall House: Boys and Girls ages 6-12 will have an exciting week of games and exercises that promote confidence, creativity and positive self image. The theme for the July camp is "*Dungeons, Dragons, Castles, and More*" set in a medieval atmosphere. The theme for August is "*A Magically, Wizardly, Awesome Camp*" where children will explore some favorite magical realms from stories and movies. Planned activities include indoor and outdoor fun, games, skill activities, singing, drumming and a field trip! All campers will receive a T-shirt.
