Jewelry Basics for Children-Begins October 2nd: Children will learn the basics of jewelry making to create bracelets, necklaces, and rings. Students will bring home a special item designed exclusively by them. All materials are provided in this "make and take home" class. Suggested age of students is 7 and up and the registration fee is \$7.00 per class. Classes are held in the Activities Center at Crandall Field from 9-10AM beginning Saturday, October 2nd. Lauren Buckley is the instructor.

Curious about Clay? October 2-November 13 Instructor Carlene Kuba will offer a 6-week Clay Hand-Building program for students 9 to 13 years of age. With a studio approach, students will have the opportunity to learn the process of making art from clay. Students will be exposed to the full process of the basic hand building techniques; pinch, coil and slab. The class starts with a 2-dimensional drawing in a sketch book and is guided through the building and finishing stages which culminates with a 3-dimensional sculpture. Along the way we will discuss form and function, aesthetics, and related art history. From start to finish, students will have an enriched opportunity to express the artist within. All pieces will be painted, fired twice and of course one of a kind! The clay, glazes, tools, and ring fees are all included in the registration fee. Registration fees are \$90 for residents of Hopkinton; \$95 for non-residents. Class begins Saturday, October 2nd from 10- 11:30am in the lower level of the Crandall House. **Class size is limited to eight students. There will be no class on October 9th, Columbus Day weekend.**

Drawing Classes with Caitlin Magner-MFA Begins October 4th

Explore the principles of drawing through simple still life arrangements. Caitlin will teach students how to create dynamic compositions through the exploration of charcoal, graphite, ink, and other mediums of your choice. The course is designed to familiarize students with the fundamentals of drawing and to cater to the individual vision of each student. All ages and levels of experience are welcome. Classes are held in the Activities Center on Mondays from 5-7P. The registration fee for a six-week session is \$50R, \$55NR or \$10 per class. Dramatic Arts for Children: Begins in October Children will participate in exercises and games that foster the skills needed to perform on stage. Children ages 5-7 meet on Monday afternoons from 4:00-5:30PM in the Activities Center beginning October 4th. Sessions for 8-13 year old children are held on Fridays in the Activities Center, beginning October 8th from 6-7:30PM. The registration fee for a *six-week session* is \$70 for Hopkinton residents and \$75 for non-residents or \$14 per class. This is an ongoing class and children may join at any time but please call the recreation department ahead of time to be placed on the roster. The instructor is Diane Bentley.

Fun with Fashion: Begins October 7th Do you have a knack with trendy, retro, or modern styles? Make your own fashion statement while developing self-confidence and style by modeling your own favorite outfits. Weekly themes will challenge your imagination and we will assist you by suggesting fashion ideas that you can find in your own closet! The *six-week session* will culminate in a *Fashion Field Trip* or the class's version of *Project Runway*! All children ages 8-12 are welcome. Sessions will be held in the Activities Center Studio on Thursdays from 6-7:30pm. The registration fee is \$55 for Hopkinton residents and \$58 for non-residents or \$10 per class.
