**Dramatic Arts for Children: Begins February 27<sup>th</sup>** Children will participate in exercises and games that foster the skills needed to perform on stage. Children ages 5-7 meet on Monday afternoons from 4:00-5:30PM in the Activities Center beginning February 27th. Sessions for 8-13 year old children are held on Fridays in the Activities Center, beginning March 2nd from 6-7:30PM. The registration fee for a *six-week session* is \$70 for Hopkinton residents and \$75 for non-residents or \$14 per class. This is an ongoing class and children may join at any time but please call the recreation department ahead of time to be placed on the roster. The instructor is Diane Bentley.

**Art Classes with Audrey Green - BFA & Master's of Special Education:** Explore and learn about different materials and techniques used to create art pieces.
