PETITION FOR ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT/ZONE CHANGE

The Hopkinton Town Council hereby gives notice that a Public Hearing will be held on Monday evening, September 21, 2020 beginning at 7:00 P.M. at the Hopkinton Town Hall, 1 Town House Road, Hopkinton, RI 02833 to consider a Petition for a Zoning Ordinance Amendment filed by Albert I. Hawkins, Jr., 20 Laurel Avenue, Westerly, RI 02891 for property owned by Albert I. Hawkins, Jr. located at 813 Main Street, Hope Valley, RI 02832 and identified as AP 14 Lot 47 a Manufacturing Zone. The applicant proposes an amendment to the District Use Table to add “Compassion Center” under Section 5 District Use Regulations to create a new category. The application is filed in accordance with Section 16 of the Zoning Ordinances of the Town of Hopkinton, as amended.
