PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 250 – HOPE VALLEY WATERLINE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM ORDINANCE

1. Open a hearing on a proposed amendment to Chapter 250 - Hope Valley Waterline Distribution System Ordinance of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Hopkinton, as amended, specifically the Prohibited Activities Section. The proposed amendment would add the following under Prohibited Activities: *G. Every property within the district may not increase development beyond the lot's current RI Department of Environmental Management (DEM) approved onsite wastewater treatment system (OWTS).*
