I would like to add one additional public records request, as shown below, since I now recall that at the pre-application meeting for the Skunk Hill solar land development proposal on October 7, 2020, the applicant acknowledged that it had agreed to donate a large parcel of land to the Hopkinton Land Trust.

Here is an excerpt from the meeting minutes of the planning board on that date:

Mr. Prellwitz: "It was brought to my attention – I don't know if this would be directed towards, uh, Attorney Craven, or to Mr. Epps, or to the other gentleman, but it has been brought to my attention that the property in the southern portion, between the panels and Lisa Lane, is on the table for being donated to the Land Trust.

Mr. Craven: "That's true."

Mr. Prellwitz: "Am I correct in that?"

Mr. Craven: "That is true, sir."
