We moved into the Arcadia Farms neighborhood last July, 2020. Our neighbors quickly updated us on the new solar farm plans and told us that the access road was determined to be made through the center of the open field off Arcadia Road.


As of a few weeks ago the digging was directly up against our property line in our backyard. We understand the plans and location of the access road may have changed and we are asking for your consideration in moving it to the center of the field, as was originally decided, to evenly divide the Arcadia Road access.

We would also like to request that a row of evergreen trees be planted in the back of our property for privacy from the access road. During the fall and winter months, the trees on our back property are barren. This wasn't an issue when we were backed up against an open field but, we now feel our privacy will be compromised with the addition of this access road.

We appreciate your consideration and look forward to an update on the access road plans.
