Old Business:

Status of the search for a replacement for the Town Manager's position, still on hold.

New Business:

Minutes of the 4/08/21 meeting were reviewed. There was a motion to approve by Geoff, seconded by Phil, and the motion carried.

It was noted that the Town budget referendum is coming up on June 8.

The opening of the Pavillion is imminent. Car shows have been being held on Fridays without incident.

Chief Palmer attended another zoom conference offered by the Police Chief's association that provided education on facial profile and racial bias in the policing environment.

The dept. is sending two officers to critical incident training next month. Included will be a module on active shooter training and protocols.

Accreditation efforts are continuing well.

New officer Carpenter is fully active and doing exemplary work.

Police Log: Police log: there was one fatal overdose; there are 61 weapon applications reviews pending and many ccl requests also pending now. Also the animal control officer was injured, however the office was maintained through the part time ACO during weekends.
