

Minutes of the Hopkinton Police Commission Meeting of 10/14/2021

The meeting was called to order at 3:35pm. Present: Captain Carrier, Phil Scalise. Geoff Cook and Bob Marvel.

Old Business:

911 numbering: Mr. Marvel notes that the ordinance is in review and he will get a good status and report out at our next meeting.

New Business:

Minutes of the 8/12/21 meeting were reviewed. There was a motion to approve by Geoff, seconded by Phil, and the motion carried.

A part time Animal Control Officer who previously worked in this position has agreed to work on weekends to fill the void, and is greatly helping to meet an important need.

New patrol person position update: there were 19 applicants fielded. 12 took the written and physical examination. A conditional offer was made to two candidates, both of whom were female. The next academy starts in Jan. 2022.

Police Log: Police log: there were again, two fatal overdoses in the past two months (Aug./Sept)

Chief Palmer received a grant of \$10k for athletic equipment for the station. The commissioners reviewed some of the new equipment purchased and noted that it was high quality, professional gym grade equipment that will serve the dept. for decades to come.

The council is to appoint a replacement for Stiles next month.

Motion to adjourn at 4:50 pm by Geoff, seconded by Phil, and the motion carried.
