Old Business:

Follow up on the status of the speed trailer: The new speed trailer is now in service! Reports have been very positive so far. The visibility is exceptional, and it appears that it will provide a great source for speeding deterrence for years to come.

Status of the search for a replacement for the Town Manager's position, currently on hold.

911 numbering efforts will be tabled until the town seats a new Town Manager. Mr. McGarry has retired, and the topic will have to be reset, explained and the effort restarted.

**New Business:** 

Reviewed and approved the minutes of 10/8/20. Stiles made a motion to accept, which was seconded by Geoff, and the motion carried.

The department's new recruit will be in service on 12/12 with formal graduation set for 12/15. She will be part of a two person team for the first three months.

The new police cruiser should be available to the force in December of this year after it receives all the lights and ancillary equipment installs.

Police Log: Police log: One overdose was reported, with no deaths. First responders were able to come to a URI College of Pharmacy, sponsored program at the station that made supplies of narcan available to them. 25 applicants attended and received the product. This was deemed a great success, and exceeded the promoter's expectations. In another event, the station was able to take back 66# of mic'l prescription drugs through the outreach program.
