FFY 2023 LIHEAP Income Eligibility

Rhode Island households are income-eligible for the Low Income Heating Assistance Program (LIHEAP) when the household's gross income is equal to or less than 60 percent of the State Median Income (SMI) for their household size. This is for mandatory as of October 1, 2022. Guidelines may be restricted based on available funding.
