

# Need Assistance Paying Your Water or Sewer Bill?



## Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP)



LIHWAP is a temporary emergency program that can help eligible households and families afford water and wastewater services, providing a one-time payment that is paid directly to the utility company. LIHWAP is available through September 2023 or until the funds are exhausted.

*To be eligible, households must have an annual income at or below 60% of the State median income and have a demonstrated need for water assistance.*

### LIHWAP can help with: FFY 2023 Low Income Guidelines

- Reconnection of water services
- Prevention of disconnection
- Past-due and current balances
